## CIRCULAR

Sub: GUIDELINES FOR THE VERTICAL PROGRESSION: 2022 SCHEME M.Tech & MCA PROGRAMS-Reg

Students are asked to note the Vertical Progression Guidelines applicable to 2022 Scheme M. Tech & MCA Programs:

- A student cannot have more than FOUR BACKLOG COURSES (F, AB, NSSR, NSAR and W) at the end of each academic year for promotion to the next higher academic year.
- Such students who do not satisfy this minimum requirement in an academic year shall **(b)** improve by registering for the courses in which they have failed (Grade F) / Declared NSAR /Declared NSSR / withdrawn (Grade W) during fast-track semester.
- If a student fails to satisfy the minimum requirements, even after the Fast Track (c) semester examinations, he/she cannot register for the next higher academic year. However, such students can register for the failed courses upto 20 Credits (for M. Tech) and 25 Credits (for MCA) with Maximum of 5 Courses respectively, during the regular odd semester or even semester courses, (if offered) to secure a grade greater than D and thus satisfy the minimum requirement for promotion to the next higher academic year.

No vertical progression between Odd to Even semester. (d)
