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(54) Title of the invention : Extraction of Cellulose Acetate from Processed Cigarette Filter Waste

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(57) Abstract :

A method of an extraction of cellulose acetate (CA) from a processed cigarette filter waste (PCFW) 100 comprising: collecting and adding processed cigarette filter waste (PCFW) to a 250 ml beaker (101); washing the PCFW in a 100 ml hot water maintained at a 50  $^{\circ}$ C and removing the floating paper from the beaker (102); washing the PCFW in a 100 ml of water maintained at 25  $^{\circ}$ C for 30 minutes and removing the remaining floating paper from the beaker (103); rinsing the washed PCFW twice in a 100 ml absolute ethanol to eliminate other constitutes of the PCFW (104); treating the rinsed PCFW with a mixture of acetone and ethyl acetate to obtain a suspension (105); adding distilled water drop by drop to the suspension to obtain a white precipitate of cellulose acetate (106); filtering the white precipitate of cellulose acetate from the solution and drying in a hot air oven at 80  $^{\circ}$ C to obtain a sample of a cellulose acetate (107); and checking a weight of sample of cellulose acetate after each hour to record the loss followed by packing the sample (108), wherein the extraction of cellulose acetate (CA) from a PCFW to handle waste PCFW in the form of fibers, sheets, rods or any other loose and held forms thus partially eliminating the use of fresh cellulose. << FIG. 1 >>

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
