Dear Parents and Students,

Greetings from RV College of Engineering, Bengaluru !!

In continuation to our earlier circular dated 03rd Nov 2020 we are herewith bringing further points for your information and needful

As per VTU Guidelines and Instructions, **Offline Classes for Laboratories for final year students of UG & PG Programs have been planned from 17th November 2020 onwards.** However, the **ONLINE CLASSES** for the III & V sem UG will continue for some more time until further notice from our side. It is not **MANDATORY/COMPULSORY** for the students to attend the offline classes. **Offline labs will be resumed only with the consent of the parents and students.**

- ❖ AS per the guidelines from VTU, the **last working day for this odd semester 2020-2021 (for all semesters of UG & PG) is 10th Jan 2021;** Classes (theory and labs) will be held till the last working day and **SEE FOR BOTH LABS AND THEORY WILL BE OFFLINE MODE ONLY;**
- ❖ Initially it is planned to conduct offline labs for 2/3 weeks (depending on the number of hardware labs) followed by **offline lab CIE.** Once the lab experiments are completed, depending on the situation of Covid-19, Online/Offline theory classes and theory CIE will be planned so that all the academic activities will be completed by **Jan 10, 2021. OFF LINE SEE for Labs and Theory will be held during III/IV Week of Jan 2021.** As per the current situation.
- ❖ Based on the logistics, final year students can plan their travel and can start **attending the offline lab sessions from 17th Nov 2020 onwards.** It is advised that the students can complete the offline lab sessions on or before **first week of Dec 2020** so that remaining theory CIE / Assignments / minor project evaluation may happen either online or offline mode depending on the COVID-19 situation in the region

Dos and Don'ts, SOP instructions, consent form for the students resuming their offline classes in campus, general guidelines are attached herewith and will be published in our college website. Two buses will play from Mysore Road Metro station to RVCE both in the morning & Evening.

Morning Session: Trip 1: 8.15 AM; Trip 2: 8.30 AM;	Evening Session: Trip 1: 5.00 PM; Trip 2: 5.30 PM;
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to Visvesvaraya
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Any changes in the schedule will be intimated to students and parents as and when we receive the notifications from UGC/State Government/VTU time to time.

We request the co-operation of all parents in sending your wards to the college with your valuable advice to wear the mask, always maintain physical distance & wash hands/sanitize as often as possible. **Without mask and thermal screening students are not permitted to enter inside the campus.** With these precautions we are confident of manoeuvring COVID-19.
