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IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW VTU AMENDMENTS FOR 2022, 2021 & 2018 SCHEMES



CIRCULAR

Sub: Implementation of new VTU Amendments for the schemes 2022, 2021 & 2018-Reg

Ref: VTU Circulars as given below:

1. VTU/BGM/Aca-Cirs/SA/2023-24/2619 Dated 21 August 2023; Vertical Progression for UG Programs in affiliated & Autonomous Colleges;
2. VTU/BGM/Aca/BoS/2020-23/611 Dated 02 May 2023;
3. VTU/BGM/ACA/2023-24/3814 dated 3 Nov 2023

The following new VTU amendments have been implemented wef 1st Jan 2024 for 2018, 2021 & 2022 Schems of undergraduate programs.

1. 2022 Scheme: Conditions for the VERTICAL PROGRESSION & new implementation of VTU amendments:

A] FIRST YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS:

1. Students having backlog courses **MORE THAN 16 CREDITS** (including NSSR, & Malpractice cases) are **NOT PERMITTED** to move to III Sem; The cases under NSAR will not be considered for the Vertical Progression.

B] SECOND & THIRD YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS:

1. **ANY NUMBER OF F'S ARE PERMITTED TO CARRY TILL THE VI SEM;**
2. The candidate who has not obtained the eligibility for III sem even after **THREE** academic years from the date of admission to I sem **shall discontinue the program** or get readmission to I sem B.E. Program.

C] FOURTH YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS:

1. Before entering to VII sem, **ALL THE I YEAR COURSES SHOULD BE COMPLETED;**
2. Degree should be completed by 8 years (REGULAR) or 6 years (FOR DIPLOMA);
3. **CGPA ≥ 5.0** is required for the award of B.E. Degree

Case A] NEW VTU AMENDMENTS FOR 2022 SCHEME OF 2022 ADMISSION BATCH

- Students having back log courses **declared NSAR & NSSR (I to II Sem)**, can register for such courses during **Fast Track semester (one time provision only)** for **maximum of 4 courses** or **up to 16 credits** (whichever is less).
- However, such students should earn both attendance & CIE and get eligibility to write SEE.
- Students having back log courses **declared F Grade in SEE (I to II Sem)**, can register for **Supplementary semester** during successive examinations (any number of courses).



- **However, such students should need not earn attendance & CIE** and write **direct SEE with earlier CIE.** (OR)
- Students having back log courses **declared F Grade in SEE** (I to II Sem), can register for such courses during Fast Track semester for maximum of 4 courses or upto 16 credits (whichever is less). However, such students should earn both attendance & CIE only and get eligibility to write SEE. **All fast Track rules of 2018 scheme applicable.**

Case B] New VTU amendments for 2022 scheme OF 2023 admission batch

- Students having back log courses **declared F Grade in SEE** (I Sem), can register for **supplementary examinations** to write SEE directly with earlier CIE along with regular II sem SEE exams.
- Students having back log courses **declared NSAR** of I Sem, can register **during II sem (regular)** up to **28 credits** including II sem credits. (courses amounting to maximum of 08 credits).
 - Classes will be conducted parallelly along with the regular II sem time table in blended mode.
 - **Both Attendance and CIE have to be earned.**
- Students having back log courses **declared NSSR** for the course/s. Re-register for the course/s **during subsequent sem (regular) and appear for SEE after obtaining a minimum of 40% in CIE.**
- **However, the candidate need not attend the classes.**

MAKE UP EXAMS FOR 2023 ADMISSION BATCH

- Make up exams for even and odd sem will be conducted **at the end of even semester once in a year.** This facility will be available for those students who have appeared & failed in SEE in one or more courses.
- Students having **minimum CIE & attendance** but could not appear for SEE for valid and convincing reasons are also eligible to take make up exams after due recommendations by the **Principal / Dean Academics.**
- Students having F Grades for courses totalling more than 16 Credits in the 1st and 2nd Semesters of first year (who are not eligible to go to 3rd Sem) are also **permitted** to appear for the make up exams.

CONDITIONS FOR THE MAKE UP EXAMS:

- **The student taken make up examinations to clear the courses are not eligible to be considered for the award of ranks**
- **Students having NSSR & NSAR are not eligible to take make up exams.**
- **No PVP provision** for the students taking make up exams
- **Make up exams are considered as an attempt.**



2. 2021 Scheme: Conditions for the VERTICAL PROGRESSION & new implementation of VTU amendments:

SUMMARY OF VERTICAL PROGRESSION (2021 Scheme)

A] FIRST-YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS:

1. Any number of F grades can be carried to III sem.

B. SECOND & THIRD YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS

1. **ANY NUMBER OF F'S ARE PERMITTED TO CARRY TILL THE VI SEM;**
2. A student who has not obtained the eligibility for III sem even after **THREE** academic years from the date of admission to I sem **shall discontinue the program** or get readmission to I sem B.E. Program.

C] FOURTH YEAR B.E. PROGRAMS

1. Before entering to VII sem, **ALL THE I YEAR COURSES SHOULD BE COMPLETED;**
2. **Degree should be completed by 8 years (REGULAR) or 6 years (FOR DIPLOMA);**

2018 Scheme: Conditions for the VERTICAL PROGRESSION & new implementation of VTU amendments:

Amendments in regulations governing the award of B.E. degree program of scheme 2018-Reg

Ref: VTU/BGM/ACA/2023-24/3816 dated 3 Nov 2023

New amendments for 2018 scheme (to be implemented from 2023-24 VII sem)

- Students having backlog courses **cleared NSAR & declared NSSR** (I to VI Sem), **can register for such courses** during the **present VII sem** (ACY 2023-24) along with the regular VII Sem courses.
- However, such students **should earn CIE only (without attending classes)** and **get eligibility to write SEE.**
- There is **no restriction for the number of failed courses** to be registered.
- Students having backlog **courses declared NSAR** (I to VII Sem), Such students should register either for:
 - **Subsequent VIII sem (ACY 2023-24)** along with the **Major Project work** (16 Credits).
 - **Courses worth Maximum of 08 Credits** is **PERMITTED.**
 - However, students should **earn both attendance & CIE.** Classes may be conducted in **blended mode.**
 - Subsequent **fast track semester** where the candidate has to **earn both attendance & CIE** as per 2018 scheme fast track regulations.



Evaluation of NPTEL [MOOC COURSES]

A] 2018 Scheme:

Once failed in Online NPTEL Courses, register in Fast Tract semester, attend classes, earn CIE & write SEE.

B] 2021 Scheme:

- Registration is online (MOOC).
- if any candidate gets F grade, in online NPTEL courses, register once again in online platform and get the certificate.
- No Offline exams in fast track.
- In the **second attempt, student can change the course**. Process of autonomous guidelines has to be followed. The candidate can select any other course from the existing basket or select a new course out of the basket. In both the cases, the respective BoS has to approve the cases and final approval from the Dean Academics for the implementation.

C] 2022 Scheme:

- Registration is online (MOOC).
- if any candidate gets F grade, in online NPTEL courses, register once again in online platform and get the certificate. No Offline exams in fast track.
- In the **second attempt student can change the course**. Process of autonomous guidelines has to be followed. The candidate can select any other course from the existing basket or select a new course out of the basket. In both the cases, the respective BoS has to approve the cases and final approval from the Dean Academics for the implementation.

D] Change of Courses: (applicable to both 2021 & 2022 Schemes)

- Under the Core Courses category, the candidate can change the course **after 4 successive failures**.
- Under professional electives category, the candidate can change the course in the **second attempt only**.
