Instructions and Code of Conduct to Students

- 1. To attend the programme Students are to register in SAP portal through their SAP id and using the password Welcome@1
- 2. Registered students are informed to follow the dress code as indicated below:

- 3. Students are required to collect the stole and kit from the assigned counter between 1.30 PM to 3.00 PM on the day of Graduation Day Ceremony in Design Thinking Huddle.
- 4. Stole and Entry pass will not be issued after 3.00 PM and they shell not allowed to receive the certificates.
- 5. Students are informed to note that only two accompaniments (Guest) and candidate (three in total) are allowed for the program.
- 6. Only the student is allowed to the venue of the program and the accompaniment is requested to watch the live telecast of the program in the other seminar hall within the campus.
