

INFORMATION ABOUT RVCE FHWS CERTIFICATE PROGRAM



The University Of Applied Sciences Würzburg-Schweinfurt (FHWS) in Bavarian state of Germany is renowned university in one of highly industrialized state “Bavaria” in Germany. FHWS was established in 1971 and is known to impart high quality education to both German and international students. FHWS is highly respected for its research and development activities being carried out in Germany. Similarly RV College of Engineering (RVCE), Bangalore, India is a well known Engineering college and ranked among top 10 Engineering College managed by a private Trust Rashtreeya Sikshana Samithi Trust (RSST). RVCE has been imparting international quality education in engineering streams for more than 50 years. Also research activities in collaboration with other research organizations are carried out at RVCE.

In view of this FHWS has chosen RVCE as its education partner and inked an exclusive memorandum of understanding (MOU). By co-operating with each other both RVCE and FHWS stand to benefit like recognition and popularity of both institutes within India and Germany, possible collaboration in research activities and student exchanges programs etc. As per the MOU, RVCE will assist Indian students to seek admission in any engineering program at FHWS. As per the rules and regulations of German higher education, students seeking to join undergraduate program in any German university shall complete 13 year of schooling education. But Indian students have only 12 years of schooling education. Hence RVCE will act as bridge to Indian students wanting to study in FHWS by conducting one year certification course at RVCE campus Bengaluru to fulfill one year deficit. The Fee for the course at RVCE is about Rs 3.0 lakhs and students will be taught subjects like basic Engineering Mathematics, Physics, Materials Science, Production Technology, Financial accounting and A1 & A2 German language. On completion of one year certification course at

RVCE, the students will automatically be eligible to join any one of the four Engineering programs at FHWS. Namely BE program in

1. Mechatronics	3. Business and Engineering
2. Robotics	4. Logistics

The Bachelors in engineering program at FHWS is a 3.5 year program. In the 7th semester students have to compulsorily undergo Internship for 6 months duration in any Industry in Germany and gain practical knowledge. Students will earn about 210 European credits during his/her Bachelors Program. There is no Tution fee in the state of Bavaria and hence students have to bear living expenses (about 853 Euros per month or 10236 Euros for one year) only. On completion of UG program either students can take up employment or continue their Master’s program in any university in Germany or EU countries.
